

My Name is Delia Forté, and I am actively involved in a community where we would like to see the conditions of the schools and the education dramatically improve. At a young age children require a solid foundation in order to grow and develop, this can only be achieved if they are provided with a warm and loving environment, which stimulates and educates them on a daily basis.

Currently there are 3 schools that I have focused on trying to upgrade:

- 1) Paindane - 789 Students with 18 teachers
- 2) Guinjata - 297 students with 7 teachers
- 3) Masavana - 874 students with 22 teachers

The floors of the classrooms have disintegrated and the classrooms don't have any school desks so the students sit on the floor. During the seasonal rains there is no school due to the fact that the classrooms are not fully enclosed and students get drenched by the rain. Masavana does have school desks, however they have a shortage of around 150 desks.

My plan is to get funding from a sponsor to build suitable classrooms. The learners and the teachers will benefit greatly from more structured environment in which to learn and teach. It is a child's right to be able to attend school and benefit education.

The sponsor will have full branding rights on the school's marketing board. All 3 schools are located along a main road toward very popular vacation spots. All 3 schools are visible from the road. Further marketing and branding rights are negotiable.
