



Translation of  
Ministerial Diploma No. 140/2010  
of 27 August

Fees for Biometric Passports & DIREs

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As it is necessary to approve the table which sets out the fees to be charged for the issuing of biometric and electronic machine-readable passports, residence authorisations and visas, and to distribute amounts resulting from the said fees in terms of Decrees 12/2008 and 13/2008, both of 29 April, and to update the fees charged for other services, using the powers conferred on it by article 5 of Decree 13/2008, read together with no. 2 of lines e), f) and g) of article 1 and 2 of article 5, both of Ministerial Diploma 85/94, of 15 June, the Ministers of the Interior and Finance decree:

Article 1 - 1. The table which sets out the fees for the issuing, renewal or substitution of machine-readable biometric and electronic passports, visas and residence authorisations, as contained in Annexures 1 and 2, is approved.

2. The Migration Services shall charge the recipients of documents and services issued and performed by it those fees contained in Annexures 1 and 2 of this Diploma, which form an integral part hereof.

Article 2 - 1. Amounts charged for the issuing, renewal or substitution of the machine-readable biometric and electronic passports, visas and residence authorisations provided for in this Diploma shall be distributed between the State and the entity appointed to manufacture such machine-readable biometric and electronic passports, visas and residence authorisations.

2. That part of the income allocated to the State, shall be distributed as follows:

a) 60% to the National Migration Directorate, to be used to pay salaries and monetary benefits, and for the improvement of services;

b) 40% for the State Budget.

Article 3. Amounts charged for the issuing, renewal or substitution of the machine-readable biometric and electronic passports, visas and residence authorisations provided for in this Diploma shall be channelled, by the Provincial Migration Services, to the Directorate of the respective tax area, by the 10th day of the month following that in which they are charged, by means of the corresponding Form B (*Modelo B*).

Article 4. Whenever necessary, the Ministers in charge of the Interior, and of Finance, may, by Diploma, authorise the updating of the distribution dealt with in article 2.

Article 5. Doubts arising from the application of this Diploma shall be clarified by an Order of the Minister of the Interior.

Article 6. This Diploma enters into force immediately.
