## **MINISTERIAL DIPLOMA 262/2010 OF 24 DECEMBER**

It being necessary to adjust the fees charged for the issuing, renewal and substitution of electronic, and biometric passports, DIREs and visas, approved under Ministerial Diploma 140/2010 of 27<sup>th</sup> August, within the framework of the State's national and international responsibilities;

Using the authority vested under Article 5 of Decree 13/2008 of 29 April in conjunction with Article 4 of Ministerial Diploma 140/2010 of 27<sup>th</sup> August the Ministers of the interior and Finance hereby determine:

### ARTICLE 1

The new table for the fees for the concession, renewal or substitution of electronic and biometric passports, DIREs and visas, provided in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 of this Ministerial Diploma are hereby approved.

### ARTICLE 2

The Immigration Service shall charge the beneficiaries of the documents and services issued or provided by that Service, the fees indicated in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 of this Ministerial Diploma, which Schedules shall be considered an integral part of said Diploma.

### ARTICLE 3

1. The amount charged for the issuing or renewal of electronic or biometric visas, and for the concession, renewal or substitution of electronic or biometric DIREs shall respect, wherever this is the case, Agreements between the Republic of Mozambique and other States or Organizations.
2. The amount charged for the issuing, renewal or substitution of electronic or biometric DIREs, when such refer to citizens of the Community of Lusophone Countries (CPLP) who seek to obtain residence authorization, are the amounts indicated in Schedule 3 of this Ministerial Diploma in accordance with Resolution 42/2004 of 22 September, which ratifies the Agreement on the

Exemption from Fees and Emoluments for the Issuing, Renewal and Authorisation of Residence, for said citizens.

3. Diplomatic, Courtesy and Official Visas shall be exempt from fees for their issuing or renewal when reciprocal arrangements to this effect exist.

#### ARTICLE 4

1. The value charged for the issuing, renewal or substitution of electronic or biometric passports, visas and DIREs provided in the present Ministerial Diploma shall be divided between the State and the entity to which the contract for issuing said documents has been adjudicated.
2. The part of the income belonging to the State shall be divided as follows:
  - a) 60% for the National Directorate of Immigration, for the purposes of guaranteeing emoluments, financial prizes and improvement of services;
  - b) 40% for the State Budget.
3. The part of the income belonging to the State and deriving from the issuing of visas shall be divided as follows:
  - a) 50% for the National Directorate of Immigration, for the purposes of guaranteeing emoluments, financial prizes and improvement of services;
  - b) 10% for the area responsible for tourism for activities related to promotion and tourism statistics;
  - c) 40% for the State Budget.

#### ARTICLE 5

The value charged for the issuing, renewal or substitution of electronic or biometric passports, DIREs and visas provided for in this Ministerial Diploma shall be passed by the Provincial Immigration Services to the Directorate of the relevant fiscal area by the tenth day of the month following that in which the amount was levied, using Form B.

#### ARTICLE 6

Wherever necessary the Ministers of the Interior and Finance shall, by means of Ministerial Diploma, update the distribution indicated in Article 4.

#### ARTICLE 7

Questions arising from the application of this Ministerial Diploma shall be clarified by Dispatch of the Minister of the Interior.

#### ARTICLE 8

Ministerial Diploma 140/2010 of 27 August is hereby revoked

#### ARTICLE 9

This Ministerial Diploma comes into force immediately.
