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Registration and updating of data for the NUIT on e-Taxation

Under the Mozambican Government's Five Year Plan, the Tax Authorities have been developing Tax and Customs reforms since 2006.

In this context, the e-Taxation Project, a technology project for the administration of domestic taxes has been set in course, which aims to use the facilities offered by information and communication technologies to improve the quality of services to citizens.

The e-Taxation Project is being implemented in phases, being currently on the NUIT deployment phase, which consists in the registration and management of information from the taxpayer by electronic means.

The NUIT Registration Module is composed of features that allow registration and assignment of NUITs to new taxpayers, early registration, amendment and termination of activities as well as updating data to previously registered taxpayers.

Therefore, in order for any taxpayer to interact with the Tax Authorities through the e-Taxation system it is necessary that they have a NUIT and that it is updated and uploaded in the system. However, it should be noted that taxpayers already with a NUIT will not be obliged to get a new one, but should rather update their data, because only then can they interact with the Tax Authorities via e-Taxation and benefit from advantages that offer:

- The possibility of payment via Bank;
- The possibility of submission of statements via internet;
- The possibility of communication with a call center;
- The possibility of access to the taxpayer portal;
- The possibility of declaring and making payments in any Financial Management Division;
- Reduction of distances for tax compliance.

IMPORTANT:

Taxpayers, in all Schemes, and the Simplified Tax for Small Contributors must update their data by December 31, 2013, and may do so at any Tax Authority Unit.
